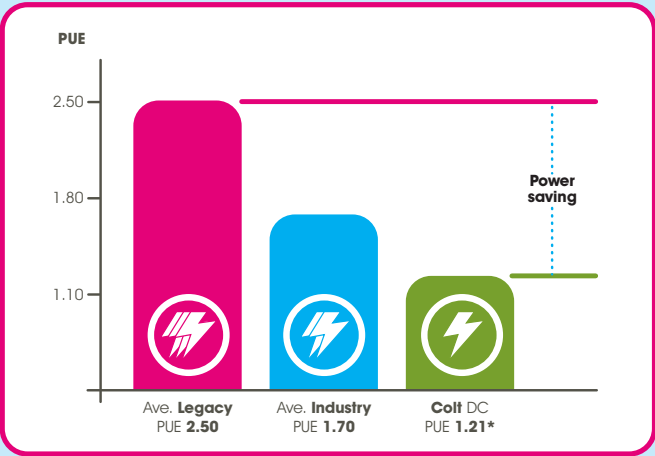
The Colt data centre: total cost of ownership (TCO)

The TCO benefits of the Colt data centre are achieved through the low levels of Power Usage Effectiveness (PUE) and the flexibility of its design.

The industry average PUE is 1.70, in legacy data centres this can be as high as 2.50. The Colt data centre, however, has an industry-leading PUE of 1.21, a significant improvement which can result in cost savings of £3 million* over 10 years in power bills.

Colt's flexibility in design and choice of services negates the need for costly design and planning exercises required in a more traditional approach.

Components in a Colt data centre are no different to a traditional data centre, but delivered in a fraction of the time with unmatched efficiencies.

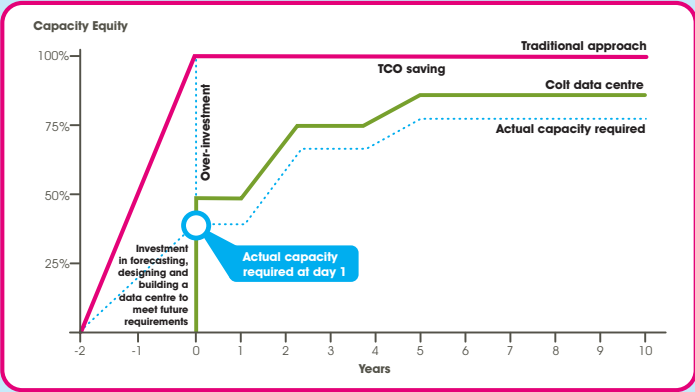

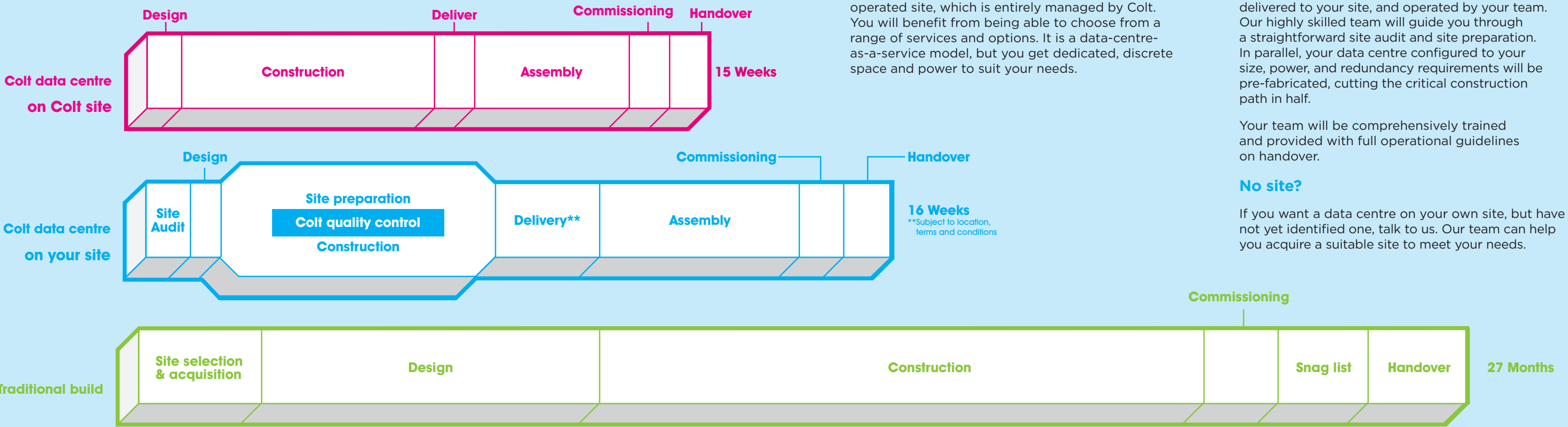
Traditional data centres can take up to three years to design, build and then commission. The often lengthy design phase is characterised by lots of modelling in an attempt to forecast the capacity of the data centre required in 18 to 24 months' time (when the data centre will be commissioned), and to estimate requirements to future proof the data centre.

Colt's design and implementation phase is just four months. This means that future requirements can be assessed on a far more frequent basis; allowing you to make more informed and practical decisions on your data centre. You scale with your business and deploy capital only when it is needed.

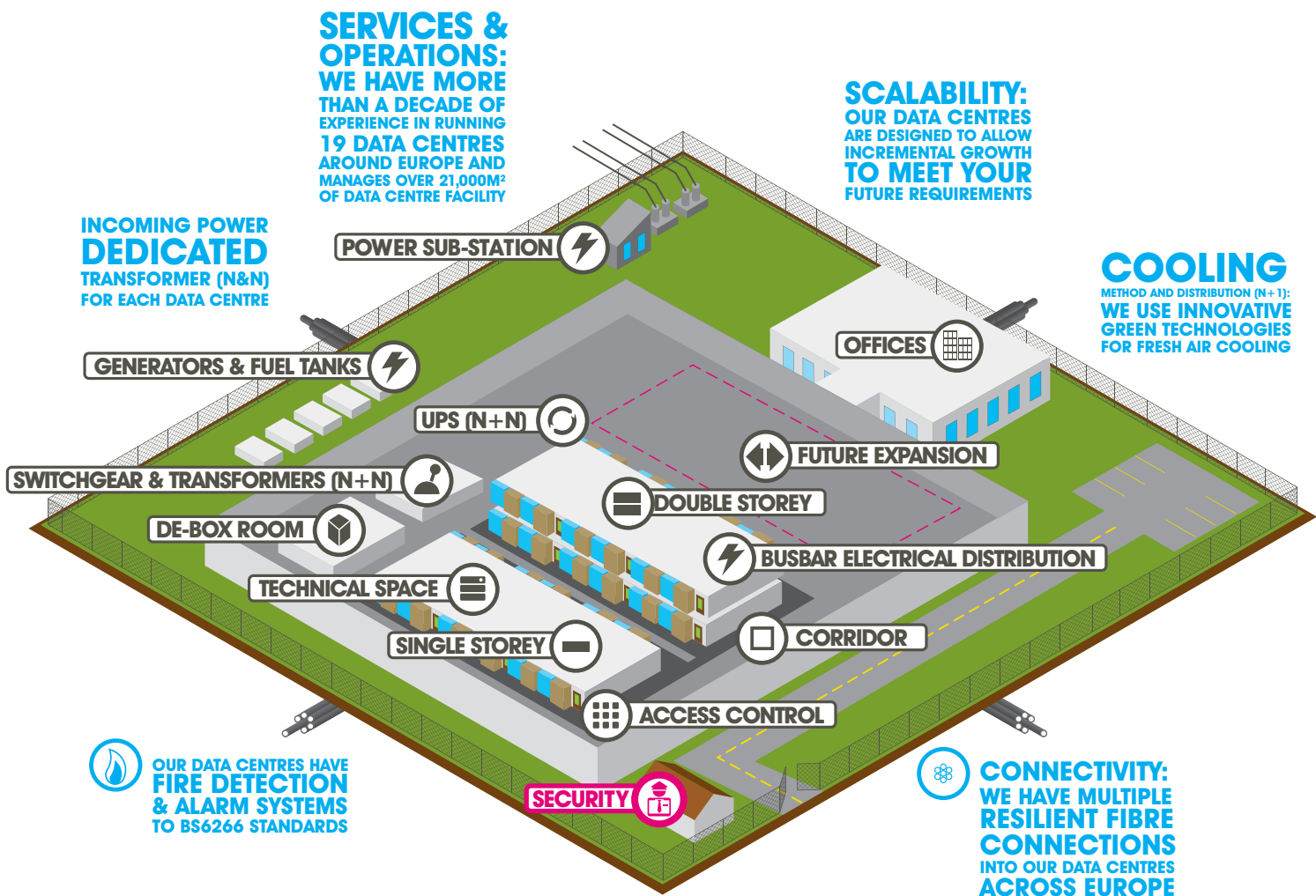
